

Kent College, Group Immersion Programmes

We are delighted to offer a short-term immersion programme, which provides the experience of British boarding school life to international students.

Our immersion programmes can support group bookings of up to 20 students during term time with one free group leader place per 10 students. The group leader must provide overnight supervision. Students between the ages of 14-16 can fully immerse themselves in the school's academic, and co-curricular offering, receive specialist EAL (English as an Additional Language) classes and enjoy cultural visits that will enrich each student's understanding of life in the UK.

Students will also participate in our enriching after-school and weekend boarding programme. This includes a variety of trips, activities on site as well as the use of the sports facilities during the weekends.

Stays are between 2 and 3 weeks.

Each girl will receive an individualised academic timetable similar to the Year 10 sample below.
